After 28 years of dedicated service to the University of Arizona and the College of Pharmacy, Dr. John E. Murphy will be retiring at the end of June 2019.

Dr. Murphy is Professor of Pharmacy Practice and Science and Associate Dean at the College of Pharmacy-Phoenix. Dr. Murphy previously served as Interim Dean (2015-2016), Associate Dean-Tucson (2007-2018), and Head of the Department of Pharmacy Practice and Science (1991-2006) at the UA College of Pharmacy. He received his BS in Pharmacy and PharmD degrees from the University of Florida.

Dr. Murphy received numerous professional and teaching awards over the years, and most recently, he was honored with the Findlay E. Russell Distinguished Citizen Award from the UA College of Pharmacy in 2018. Other accolades include the Robert K. Chalmers Distinguished Educator Award from the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy in 2015, the Harvey A. K. Whitney Lecture award from the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists in 2014, the Education Award from American College of Clinical Pharmacy in 2012, and the Award for Sustained Contributions to the Literature of Pharmacy Practice from the ASHP Foundation in 2003. Students from the College named him as Educator of the Year twice.

Dr. Murphy has accomplished much during his trajectory here and he has left his mark on our students, alumni, faculty and staff as well as the pharmacy profession. Dr. Murphy will fondly be missed.
