Health Sciences Innovation Building (HSIB) project - Construction has begun

The fences are going up around the site for the new Health Sciences Innovation Building (HSIB). Crews will be removing light poles and clearing the site to gear up for excavation to begin in July. HSIB is the latest project in the expanding UAHS campus and will be coordinated with the ongoing construction of the Bioscience Research Lab Building (BSRL) and the Banner Hospital projects. Construction of HSIB is scheduled to be complete in July 2018.

HSIB Construction Impacts:

- Alternative parking for lot #2012 permit holders is available in the Highland Garage. Limited service parking and accessible parking will remain available on the northwest corner of the lot.
- Pedestrians traveling east/west across Cherry Ave. will be detoured to Helen or Drachman.
- Pedestrians can access the Medical Research Building from the Warren Mall. When construction is complete, Mabel will be reopened as a pedestrian/bike path.
