Dr. William Dalton presents about how data science will revolutionize medical research and healthcare. Dr. Dalton will discuss the importance of business theory in developing and utilizing health information systems to create an "ecosystem of shared value through collective impact."

**Wed., November 15, 2017**  
Dr. Fernando Martinez presents, "Microbes as co-rulers of our lives." Dr. Martinez is a researcher and clinician that studies the natural history of childhood asthma, and the role of genetic, physiological, immunological and environmental factors as determinants of the risk for asthma in early life.
